Annual Report of the Commander for the Officer Term of 2018-2019.

We have completed another very busy and successful year. Our focus during the year has been on community involvement, public relations, building improvements and renovations, and our 100 Year Rededication.

We have been featured in articles in the Long Island Advance and Greater Patchogue.

We continue to expand our community involvement with activities at Alive After Five and the Suffolk County Marathon. Our color guard has been active at Special Olympics, home owner associations, and local nursing facilities. We have expanded our involvement with the Vets in the Classroom program to include the Saxton Middle School. The Flag Etiquette classes at South Ocean Middle School were a great success, and this year we have expanded that program to include Saxton Middle School. The Post is looking to expand our Flag Day program and Veterans Day activities to include other local housing complexes. We have also formed our Honor Guard Firing Detail which did the firing salute on Memorial Day and will be doing the honors at the Missing In America Project interments at Calverton.

We have spent a lot of time working on renovations to the Post. This past year, we have received close to \$40,000 dollars of donated renovations and improvements. These include the Heating and AC units, landscaping, painting, stair lifts, and new floor and ceiling tiles in the main hall. We also have a \$50,000 grant from Senator Croci that will allow us to renovate the kitchen area, put in a new bathroom in the dugout, replace the heating system in the main hall, and replace the sink in the dugout. We also completed repairs on the fireplace and chimney.

Finally, we worked very hard on our 100 Year rededication. The Post was founded in August of 1919. On August 15, 1919, the National Executive Committee approved our application for a Post in the American Legion. In order to celebrate our accomplishment of 100 years of service, we worked with both the Village of Patchogue and the Chamber of Commerce. Our first and most important requirement for our 100 Year rededication dealt with involving the community. We rededicated the Post on Memorial Day to start our second 100 years of service.

Financially, the Post is solvent and in good condition.
